Suction-Scanning technology: Amiad's greatest achievement has been the research, development and production of suction-scanning technology. This has led to the design and production of self-cleaning filters with screen areas that were previously unattainable. Suction-scanning technology combines focused flush with automation to provide 100% cleaning of the screen area.
