### Molding Compounds

Dor's molding compounds division is one of the three major molding compound producers in the western hemisphere with market share for technical application of 15%-20%. This is a market growing 5-7% annually, so the new manufacturing plant is expected to increase its market share.

The company manufactures thermo-deviations pressing powders based on urea and melamine for the electrical accessories (plug sockets, fuses etc.), textiles (buttons), the kitchen (plates servers etc.) and sanitary (toilets). These products are heat resistant, durable and retain their color.

### Adhesives Verolit

Plastic adhesives (on a PVA base) for the wood, formica and building industries. Adhesives for cardboard boxes, paper bags, wood blocks (white and yellow), glue for offices, toilet paper rolls, lamination layers, end glue, pick up glue, book-binding adhesives.

Hot melt adhesives for paper coverings, citrus fruit and vegetables, wood, PVC, veneer, PET bottle labels, cardboard boxes, bookbinding, packaging labels to withstand chilling, paper labels on boxes. Adhesives on natural bases and acrylic and polyurethane based for labels on tires, cardboard containers, glass bottle labels, envelope adhesive, PP and PVC labels on bottles, paper labels on cans, carpet labels. The company's contact adhesives production line has added value for recycled solvents. Uses: general contact adhesives, mattresses, for spluttering, for rubber, polyurethane glue for PVC, and for PVC sheets on wood.
