Vulcan Automotive Industries Ltd. is Israel's premier manufacturer of automotive batteries, controlling close to 40% of the local market. The company recorded sales of approximately NIS 93 million in 2008 thanks to a substantial increase in exports to Europe.

Volta

Vulcan's factory located in the Tefen Industrial Park in the Western Galilee produces high-quality maintenance free batteries. The company's batteries are sold under the VOLTA label, the brand name appearing in its advertising and other commercial activities. Vulcan's nationwide marketing network is based on warehouses and sales offices located throughout Israel.



History

In 1936 Mr. Laslau founded Vulcan in Haifa. During World War II the British Mandate authorities requisitioned the factory and channeled production into the war effort. In 1946 Vulcan was purchased by Solel Boneh which then sold the company to Koor Industries and in turn Koor sold the firm to Sonol in 1952. In 1990 Vulcan's shares were issued on the Tel Aviv Stock Exchange. Since early 2010, Vulcan's shares are not registered for trade. The company's shareholders today are Focus Capital Group Ltd. (66%) and the general public (34%).
