**E**stablished in 1943 as a metal chips factory for Israel's institutional market (Israel Electric Corp., Bezeq Telecommunications, Egged Bus Co. etc.), the company acquired German know-how in 1975 and operates in forging for non-ferrous metals.

## Main Metals

The factory works mainly with aluminum, copper, brass, bronze, and stainless steel. Over the years the factory has excelled in its ability to weld two types of metals (for example aluminum and copper) to make them inseparable because they are joined together so strongly.

This welding is carried out by two different technologies - flat and rolling forging. Products are welded together from the two required metals mainly for the electrical industry. Two large

## Quality Control

The factory has a strict quality control department. Since October 1995 the factory has held ISO 9001 certification and works under the instructions and approval of the Ministry of Environmental Protection and its waste materials are transported to approved refuse sites. The liquid systems operate on a closed system with recycled water.

The factory also has an assembly and packaging department that carries out further quality assurance on every product sent to the customer.

## Plastic Injection

In 1995 the company introduced plastic injection and completes manufacturing products in the electricity sector in which it is found today. The plastic department manufactures products as a subcontractor. The factory has 9 injection machines able to inject



presses in the factory of 800 tons and 400 tons are screw presses. The factory has eight smaller presses. The firm also has a C.N.C. department with 7 machines for completing the company's products (work solely for C.N.C. is not accepted except in special circumstances).

## Molds

The firm also has a molds department manufacturing a substantial part of the factories moulds and elements, and maintaining the existing mould system. This department has a computerized solid work and Simatron system.

between 50 and 400 tons. The raw materials used by the factory are polypropylene, polycarbonate, ARS, nylon acetal, polystyrene and more.

## Worldwide Exports

The factory exports 30% of its products overseas mainly to Australia and in Europe to Germany, UK, France, Italy, Spain, Holland, Sweden, Switzerland, Cyprus, Belgium and more.

The factory also has the ability to manufacture specific exceptional products as required by customers. The molds department assists customers in planning products in order to manufacture them in the most efficient and cost savings way.
