Siemens offers a wide range of solutions and services in Israel, where its Energy, Healthcare, Industry and Transportation domains hold leading positions. In fiscal year 2013, Siemens scored major successes in Israel in all fields:

Energy

Siemens leads the energy market in Israel, with more than 30 percent of the country's electricity produced by Siemens-made gas and steam turbines and generators. All the gas turbines are maintained through long-term service agreements. In addition, Siemens Israel signed an engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) contract with a domestic independent power provider for its 439 MW combined cycle power plant (CCPP). Siemens will also provide two 50 MW gas turbines and two 25 MW steam turbines

X-Ray rooms, a catheterization laboratory (cath lab) systems, a positron emission tomography/computed tomography system (PET/CT) at Sha'are Zedek Hospital in Jerusalem.

Assuta Medical Center recently placed an order for a PET/MRI system and Sourasky Medical Center in Tel Aviv ordered three MRI systems. In addition, Siemens stands at the forefront of brain research performed on MRI systems at Israel's leading academic institutions, such as Tel Aviv University, Weizmann Institute and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

Industry

Siemens Israel continues to serve as a strategic supplier of control, drive and automation solutions to local industries.

In 2013, the Industry Automation and Drive Technologies Divisions won a contract to supply magnetic flow meters to the national water carrier, for the fifth consecutive year. In addition, the Drive Technologies Division successfully delivered rectifiers and a control system to a magnesium plant near the Dead Sea. Dead Sea Works, a world-wide leader in potash production, selected Siemens' Drive Technologies Division to upgrade the variable frequency drives (VFD) and control systems for its Tzefa conveyor system.

Transportation

Siemens is one of Israel Railways' key suppliers, to which it supplied 118 passenger coaches.
